

## **Dress Code Policy**

**Shirts/blouses:** Only solid maroon, gray, navy, black, or white knit polo-style shirts (either short or long sleeved), or oxford-style shirts or blouses in these colors. No sleeveless apparel. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. A small manufacturing logo is acceptable.

**Pants/Shorts:** Khaki, black, or navy blue dress pants/shorts only. Pants may have a flat or pleated front. Material can be cotton blends, corduroy, wool, or poly blends. Denim is excluded. Leggings and low rise slacks are also excluded. Students in K-4 th may wear shorts/slacks with elastic waist bands. Students in grades 5-8 need to wear a belt.

**Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers:** In the same fabrics as noted above. Skirts, skorts, and jumpers may be pleated or straight. Length must be no more than ankle length or no more than three inches above the knee when kneeling.

**Shoes:** Shoes that have the front and back closed, covering the entire foot, and extends no higher than just above the ankle is acceptable. Primary colors of shoes must be brown, black, white, or navy blue. Shoes should not display inappropriate pictures, language, lights, or wheels. Flip flops are also excluded.

**Belts:** Belts must be worn in grades 5-8, and must be brown, black, or navy.

**Socks:** Socks must be worn at all times. Colors are white, khaki/brown, maroon, black, navy, or gray.

**Sweaters:** Sweaters need a straight hem and must be pullover, zipper, or button in school colors. No sweatshirts, hoods, or fleece. Colors include maroon, gray, white, navy blue, black, or khaki.

**Hair:** Hair should be neat and clean at all times, and out of the eyes. NO extreme hairstyles. Hair must be kept above collar-length for boys.

**Girls Only:** Modest Jewelry may be worn.

**Boys Only:** Facial hair and earrings are not permitted.

**Scout Uniforms:** Scout Uniforms may be worn on meeting days only.

**Spirit Day:** A St. Paul School T-shirt, polo-shirt, or sweatshirt may be worn. Neat jeans with no holes or patches may be worn. St. Paul hoodies may be worn indoors only on Spirit Day.
