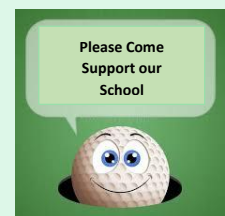
Some of the outreach that Camp Restore has helped with in the past include:

Extended Care

You will be billed when your account balance is depleted. Statements will be emailed to you biweekly. **Students will not be able to use Extended Care if your payments are not made on time.**

Procedure For Absence
