Why? Because we're a family, not just a school.

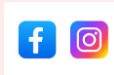
We are small and Mighty! Some might see our size as a limitation, but we see it as our greatest strength. We've just made extra room for:

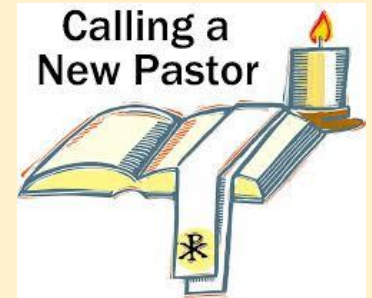

Third Quarter Chapel Offerings: Lead a Child

Thank you for your continued generosity. Our most recent chapel offerings raised \$37.04 for Lead a Child, bringing our year-to-date total to \$977.55—a beautiful reflection of our students’ servant hearts.

Donations help provide scholarships, school supplies, and teacher training so children can learn in Christ-centered environments around the world.

Registration Open for 2026/2027 – Tuition Updates

Each year, the leadership of the church examines school tuition rates for the following year.

Options are discussed and the rate is set. While tuition has increased slightly this year, the leadership with the support of the congregation, have decided to continue with keeping the family discount, meaning the tuition rate will not be greater than the two-child rate no matter how many siblings attend the school. More good news- we are continuing our incentive program. When you recruit a new family to join the school, your family and the new family will each receive a \$500 credit on your tuition bill. Ask Mrs. Hansen in the school office for a copy of the 2026/2027 fees sheet if you need an additional copy.



The church already funds a significant portion of the total cost of educating each student, but we want you to know that our support of this vital ministry continues, and we continue creative ways to increase our student body. Registration for Preschool and K-8 is now open for the 2026/2027 school year! Current families received an email from FACTS last Friday for reenrollment. Please reach out to Mrs. Hansen at 248-546-6555 or jhansen@stpaulroyaloak.org if you have any questions. Registration is \$350 for K-8 now until March 10th, then the price goes up to \$450 until June 10th, and \$500 thereafter. Preschool registration is \$170 per child.
