SCHOOL PICNIC: Permission slips are due Friday, June 2. The school picnic will be at Bloomer State Park in Rochester Hills. We have rented the Stone Shelter for the day. Also, make arrangements for the end of the day – with the designated parent taking your child home or coming back to school for pick-up. Note: There is no extended care on this day.** Plan on meeting at the park at 9:00 a.m., when the teachers will arrive.

REPORT CARD CHANGE: In order to give teachers a reasonable amount of time to complete your child's fourth quarter report card, the final report card of the school year will be mailed to your house during the week of June 12.

PAST DUE TUITION, LATCHKEY, LIBRARY FINES/BOOKS, UNSERVED SERVICE HOURS are due by June 9. Report cards will not be issued to students if financial obligations have not been met.

THE LAST DAY of school is Friday, June 9. Please join us at 10:00 a.m. in the church for awards. Children will receive certificates for perfect church attendance, perfect school attendance, some music awards, and honor roll. At 11:00 a.m. you are invited to our closing service at the church. School will be dismissed at noon.



REENROLLMENT: Registration for K-6th grade is now \$350. After June 10, it will go up to \$400. Preschool registration is \$150. If you are planning on returning to St. Paul in the fall, please send the form in today. We are already getting ready to order books etc. and need to know actual numbers. Sending in your re-enrollment now will save you \$50, and also help us in preparation for a new school year. Thank you.
