



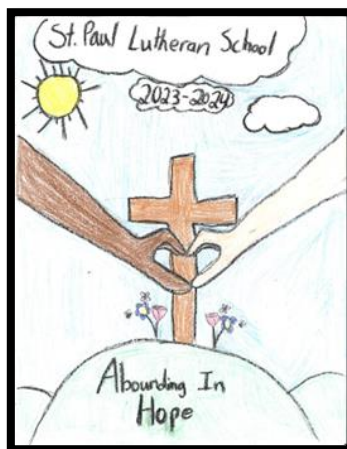
Spring Blessings

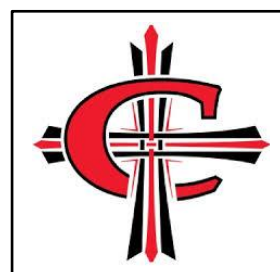
